CIS Observer Team Monitored the Presidential Election in Turkmenistan

Upon the invitation of the Central Commission for Elections and Referenda of Turkmenistan the CIS Observer Team performed monitoring of presidential elections which took place on 12 February 2017.

During the monitoring period the members of the Observer Team met with Chair of the Central Commission for Elections and Referenda of Turkmenistan Gulmurad Muradov and visited voting stations in all precincts of Turkmenistan and the city of Ashgabat.

At the concluding press conference, which took place on 13 February, Head of the CIS Observers Team at the presidential election in Turkmenistan, Chairman of the CIS Executive Committee—Executive Secretary Sergei Lebedev summarized the work of the Observers Team both during campaigning and the election itself. He noted that the voting process was smooth and well-organized, with a high activity of citizens.



According to the observers, the presidential election was conducted in compliance with the Constitution and the Electoral Code of Turkmenistan, and, generally, in line with international standards for democratic elections.

Director of the IPA CIS IIMDD Dmitriy Gladei also participated in the work of the Observer Team.
