The year 2023 was declared the Year of the Russian Language as a Language of Interethnic Communication in the CIS by the decision of the CIS Heads of State Council.

The main event dedicated to this topic in the work plan of the IPA CIS will be the **international conference "Russian Language as a Basis for Integration Dialogue in the CIS**".

The organizers of the conference together with the IPA CIS are the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation, the Russian National Library, the Boris Yeltsin Presidential Library, St. Petersburg State University, Herzen State Pedagogical University of Russia, the International Association of Teachers of Russian Language and Literature, Guild of Linguists-Experts on Documentation and Information Disputes.

The plenary session and roundtables of the conference will be held on **26-27 October 2023 in St. Petersburg at the Tavricheskiy Palace**, as well as at other venues of the co-organizers.

Representatives of legislative and executive authorities of the CIS Member Nations, relevant institutions of culture, science and education, international organizations, business and academic communities, mass media are invited to participate in the Conference.

A **final resolution** will be adopted based on the results of the conference.

- translation of model legal texts as a means of interpretation and utilisation of the world experience at the national level;
- topical issues of legal linguistics;
- principles and special features of forensic linguistic expertise.

Roundtable "Russian language in the CIS educational space: functioning parameters and prospects of spreading"

<u>Organizers:</u> the International Association of Teachers of Russian Language and Literature, the CIS Interparliamentary Assembly

Topics for discussion:

- Russian language in the system of general education: national programs, preparation and professional development of pedagogical staff, results of joint projects on the development of educational literature;
- Russian language in higher education: areas of research, national schools of Russian studies, new approaches to teaching scientific style of speech and language for special purposes;
- the best practices of Russian universities in the CIS countries, activities of branches of Russian universities and areas of mutually beneficial cooperation with higher education institutions of the CIS countries;
- key challenges for the infrastructure of Russian language teaching in the CIS countries: inflow of young staff, provision of educational literature, employment of young people with knowledge of Russian, the factor of competition with other world languages.

Roundtable "Russian as a translation language in the CIS space"




